# Sectoral Department/Achievements for the month of February, 2026

## SOCIAL SECTORS

### 1. Health & Medical Education Department:

- 249 Bedded Labour Block of SMGS hospital has been inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister and made functional. This shall substantially enhance the mother and child care tertiary services.
- **24 DM/MCH seats approved viz:** GMC Jammu (8), GMC Srinagar (10) and SKIMS (6) respectively. This shall pave way for super specialist services in the J&K, helpful in patient delivery healthcare services.
- **National Quality Assurance Standards:** As per report of NQAS certification, 15 new health facilities have been certified during month of February 2026 aggregating total of 382 including, 203 National & 179 State certifications.
- **DNB:** During the month of February, 02 Post MBBS Diploma in Radio Diagnosis seats approved for AH GMC Handwara. Total No. of DNB Seats in UT of J&K ending February 2026 is 394.
- **NTEP:** Under National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP), against the tentative target of 11,200 for the calendar year 2026 against TB notifications, 1,564 TB Notifications has been done w.e.f. Jan 2026 to February 2026, with 972TB Notifications during the month of February 2026.
- **NP-NCD:** Under Non-Communicable Disease (NCD) Screening, 1,47,816 persons were screened for Hypertension and 1,50,566 for Diabetes during the month of Feb -2026.
- **Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme:** Under PMNDP, during the month of February 980 patients served & 62725 (cumulative) sessions held upto ending February.
- Operationalisation of Health & Wellness Centres/AAMs under CPHC-Total AAMs operational ending February 3170 with 2 AAMs operationalized during the month of February, 2026.

### 2. Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj:

- 454 Houses have been completed under PMAY (G) during the month
- 36.82 lakhs Person days have been generated under MGNREGA. An expenditure of Rs 298.07 crores has been incurred.
- 356 Gram Panchayats have been social audited during the month.
- 125 SHG's & 37 Village organisations have been promoted during the month.
- 922 Community Sanitary Complexes were constructed and 25600 Individual Household Latrines (IHHL) has been constructed upto ending February,2026.
- 20 Solid waste management units & 1374 Grey water management units have been

installed during the month.

- 113 youth have been completed skill training during the month and 59 candidates provided jobs (placement made) under Himayat Scheme (DDU-GKY).
- 129 works of different nature have been completed during the month, there by aggregating the total works completed to 914 ending February, 2026. Also 1828 Hectares area has been treated during the month, thereby aggregating the total area treated to 8593 hectares ending February, 2026 under Integrated Watershed Management Programme (WMP).
- 27 Panchayat Ghars completed under Rastriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) during the month.

### **3. Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department:**

- A total of 3.22 lakhs inter-state and 49.04 lakhs intra-state portability transactions have been recorded under the all scheme across the country.
- The PDS currently covers 24.73 lakhs households, benefiting 99.32 lakhs individuals.
- To enhance transparency and credibility in the Public Distribution System (PDS), e-KYC has been completed for 93.11% (62.09) of beneficiaries under the National Food Security Act (NFSA). Additionally, 86.64% (26.26 lakhs) of Non-Priority Households (Non-NFSA) beneficiaries have also completed e-KYC as on date. POS devices working online 6388 and offline 210 and Adhaar/OTP Authenticated distribution made now upto 72.14%.
- This department vide Government Order No. 34 -JK(FCS&CA) of 2025 Dated: 05-05-2025 has decided to include children of age of 6 years & above or upon attaining the age of 6 years in Public Distribution System in their respective AAY, PHH, NPHH or Exclusion family ration cards/ households, as the case may be and also to include any left out eligible beneficiary under Public Distribution System, if not covered so far, as per norms.
- Further, any case of a widow or a divorcee, not covered under Public Distribution System, is reported to the Department, such widow(s)/divorcee(s) shall be provided a separate ration card in PHH, NPHH or Exclusion group, as the case may be, depending upon the financial status, and conformity to NFSA rules, so as to provide them coverage under Public Distribution System.
- This department has initiated the provision of additional food grains, free of cost, to all eligible AAY beneficiaries aiming to further strengthen food security for the most economically vulnerable sections of society.
- State and District Commissions conduct Lok Adalats time to time for speedy disposal of cases. State and District Commissions also have the provision to conduct National Lok Adalats as per the direction and schedule provided by National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi.

- In another important reform, the Enforcement Rules under the Legal Metrology Act have been approved in principle by the Finance Department, enhancing regulatory oversight and ensuring fairness in trade practices. Additionally, under the Jan Vishwas Act, seven provisions of the Legal Metrology Act have already been decriminalized, with eleven more under consideration, significantly improving ease of doing business and strengthening the BRAP performance of Jammu & Kashmir.

#### **4. School Education Department:**

- 165 No. of civil works (157 under Samagra Shiksha and 08 No. of works under UT Capex) have been completed during the month.
- **Career Guidance/Mental Health Activities:** Schools organized career guidance sessions and mental health awareness programmes to help students make informed career choices and to promote emotional well-being.
- Internet Safer Day -On the occasion of Internet Safer Day, awareness programmes were organized to educate students about safe and responsible use of the internet, cyber security, and digital ethics. Activities such as lectures, discussions, and awareness campaigns were conducted.
- **Pariksha-Pe-Charcha-** In order to motivate students and address examination-related stress, the programme **Pariksha Pe Charcha** was organized in all the districts. The event focused on guiding students on effective preparation strategies, time management, and maintaining a positive mindset during examinations.
- Various awareness activities including pledge ceremonies, seminars, rallies, painting competitions, and quiz competitions were conducted in schools to promote awareness on Nasha Mukta Abhiyan.
- Organized 05-day workshop on Holistic Progress Card for Secondary Stage and Standardization of Question Paper Templates.
- Organized Advocacy/Orientation Programme on Population/Adolescence Education and School Health & Wellness Programme.
- Capacity Building Programme: - Under Capacity Building Programme through JKSCERT and DIETs, 2467 faculty members have been trained during the month.

#### **5. Tribal Affairs Department:**

- **Establishment of FRA Cells:** For establishment of Forest Rights Act (FRA) Cells at the UT level and in all districts of J&K, manpower has been engaged on an outsourcing basis through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal. The tendering process has been completed and the L1 bidder, Comtech Info Solutions Pvt. Ltd., has been declared.

#### **6. Social Welfare Department:**

- Under Supplementary Nutrition Programme 7.93 lakhs beneficiaries including Pregnant/Lactating women and children under 06 years of age were provided Nutrition in the

month of February, 2026.

- 52,789, Community Based Events, 7,083 Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition Days were conducted under POSHAN Abhiyaan in the month of February, 2026.
- 96% Children immunized in the month of February, 2026.
- 96% of the Women received ANCs in the month of February, 2026.
- 12,139 (9,017 for 1st child and 3,122 for 2nd Girl child) No. of the beneficiaries were enrolled under PMMVY in the month of February, 2026..
- 8.36 lakhs beneficiaries have been registered on POSHAN Tracker application.
- 33,589 total no. of anaemia camps were organized under Anaemia Mukta J&K with 5395 no. of identified anaemic beneficiaries.
- 354 income generating units have been established in the month of February, 2026 for which 1419 persons provided Employment under WDC schemes.
- 53 income generating units have been established in the month of February, 2026, for which 140 persons provided Employment under direct Financing Schemes of SC/ST/BC Corp.

## **7. Skill Development Department:**

- Kashmir Government Polytechnic College, Srinagar successfully organized a "Sellers Meet" on 27th October 2025 under Mission YUVA to sensitize and onboard entrepreneurs onto the Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC) platform. The event marked a significant step toward promoting digital inclusion and entrepreneurship in the region.
- Kashmir Government Polytechnic College (KGP), Gogji Bagh, Srinagar achieved a significant milestone in promoting skill development and entrepreneurship under the flagship Mission YUVA (Yuva Udyami Vikas Abhiyan). As on 06.02.2026, the institution successfully conducted 35 batches (including parallel batches) of the Capacity Building Training Programme in offline mode on campus. A total of 1,283 candidates registered, out of which 679 candidates have been issued certificates upon successful completion of the programme.
- The Institution of Engineers (India) (IEI), J&K State Centre organized a Stakeholders' Meeting and Student Chapter Meet on 11th February 2026 at Kashmir Government Polytechnic College, Srinagar, facilitating interaction among stakeholders and students for professional and academic development.
- A batch of students from Kashmir Government Polytechnic College, Srinagar is undergoing hands-on training at the MSME Development Facilitation Office (MSME-DFO), Srinagar, under the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India, providing practical exposure in entrepreneurship and industrial practices.
- Government Polytechnic for Women, Jammu successfully completed Day-6 of the Basic

Skilling Assessment for the Carpenter Trade under the PM Vishwakarma Scheme on 14th February 2026.

- Government Polytechnic for Women, Jammu conducted a one-week training programme on "Basic Computer Skills" for employees of the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board (SMVDSB), Katra, aimed at strengthening their digital competencies. The programme was conducted in two phases (09.02.2026–14.02.2026 and 16.02.2026–21.02.2026) under the guidance of Er. Neelanjana Manwati, Principal, with 30 employees trained, who were awarded certificates upon completion.
- Five students of Government Polytechnic College, Nagam-Budgam are participating in the Bharat Darshan Tour 2026, organized by the 14 Battalion, Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB), Nagam, Budgam, under its Civic Action Programme.
- Government Polytechnic College, Budgam achieved distinction at the India Skills Competition 2025-26 (UT Level), where Ms. Amreena Bhat and Ms. Sabhat Farooq, students of 6th Semester Mechanical Engineering, secured 1st and 2nd positions respectively in CNC Turning. Moreover these students have also completed a specialized training boot camp at IIT Jammu, organized by the Jammu & Kashmir Skill Development Mission (JKSDM) to enhance their technical competencies in preparation for higher levels of the competition. They will now represent UT of Jammu & Kashmir at the Regional-Level India Skills Competition 2025-26, scheduled to be held in Jaipur.
- Government Polytechnic College, Budgam signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST) to promote academic collaboration, research, and skill development initiatives.
- Government Polytechnic College, Ramban organized a visit of 20 final-semester students to IIT Jammu on 7th February 2026 to attend the Pragyaan-26 Workshop. The students received exposure to circuit-making, project demonstrations, and emerging technologies including Artificial Intelligence, Physics, and Mechanical Engineering.
- Students of the Food Craft Institute (FCI), Jammu visited the Jammu Convention Centre to attend the "One District One Product" (ODOP) initiative of the Department of Industries & Commerce, J&K, and gaining exposure to regional products, entrepreneurship opportunities, and promotion of local industries.
- Four students of the CS/IT Department, Government Polytechnic College, Jammu qualified for the State-Level Competition under Skill India Competition 2025-26.
- Two NCC Cadets of Government Polytechnic College, Jammu — Cadet Amit Verma and Cadet Imran — were felicitated by the Principal for participating in the Republic Day Camp (RDC) Parade 2026 held at New Delhi, bringing pride to the institution.

### **Capacity Building under Mission YUVA:**

- Under Mission YUVA, the Jammu & Kashmir Skill Development Mission (JKSDM) is implementing capacity-building programmes across Polytechnics and Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) of the Union Territory. The initiative focuses on strengthening

institutional readiness and enhancing entrepreneurship, employability, and innovation among youth. So far, around 3,000 participants have been successfully trained, and the programme is now being expanded to JKEDI district centres and Government Degree Colleges across the UT.

### **Implementation of PM Vishwakarma Yojana in collaboration with Directorate of Skill Development (Polytechnic/ ITIs) and NSDC Centers.**

The status of PM Vishwakarma status as on 31-10-2025 is as under:

- Total beneficiaries registered: 1.54 lakhs

### **Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 4.0**

- The J&K Skill Development Mission has been allocated training targets for 5,600 candidates across the Union Territory. Mobilization of candidates is currently in progress for 44 approved job roles, aligned with NSQF standards and local industry demand, and around 4,000 candidates have been mobilized so far. 3,000 candidates have already been enrolled, and training batches have commenced in three Training Centres (TCs), while additional Training Centres are in the process of being aligned. The mapping of Training Centres has been completed. Necessary arrangements for batch formation and training delivery are being undertaken to ensure timely allocation and achievement of training targets.

## **8. Higher Education Department:**

- **Pariksha Pe Charcha (PPC) 2026:** The students of various Government Degree Colleges of JK UT successfully participated in the live telecast interaction of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India during the 9th edition of Pariksha Pe Charcha (PPC) 2026 held on 6th February 2026 at 10:00 AM through the Google Meet Platform.
- **National Science Day:** National Science Day is celebrated in India every year on February 28 to commemorate the discovery of the 'Raman Effect' by Sir C. V. Raman in 1928, for which he was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930. The theme for National Science Day 2026 is "Women in Science: Catalyzing Viksit Bharat," highlighting the vital role of women in STEM fields and emphasizing their contribution toward building a developed and self-reliant nation.
- **Goonj-2026:** The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Jammu & Kashmir, **Sh. Manoj Sinha**, inaugurated the 3rd edition of the multi-genre youth festival, 'Goonj-2026,' at the University of Jammu. The festival was organized under the vision "Dissolving Boundaries, Evolving Education," emphasizing trans-disciplinary collaboration and greater synergy among departments. More than 600 students registered for the festival, representing University teaching departments, offsite campuses, affiliated colleges, and neighbouring institutions.

- **Youth Interaction Series under the Mission YUVA:** The Youth Interaction Series under the Mission YUVA (Young Urban Volunteer Associate) empowerment scheme, primarily operating in Jammu and Kashmir, aims to foster entrepreneurship and financial literacy among individuals aged 18–59. Students participated in a series of programmes under the Youth Parliament initiative w.e.f. 20th to 25th February, 2026. These interactions included “Login Day” events, orientation-cum-interaction programmes for “YUVA DOOTs,” Training and awareness camps designed to connect beneficiaries with credit facilities and various Government support mechanisms, thereby promoting self-employment and sustainable livelihood opportunities.
- **Safer Internet Day 2026 :** Safer Internet Day 2026 was observed on February 10<sup>th</sup> across all the institutions of Higher Education with the theme "AI Aware: Safe, Smart, and in Control," The day focused on promoting digital literacy in the age of Artificial Intelligence, encouraging critical thinking, and fostering responsible online behaviour among Youths.
- **World Cancer Day 2026:** World Cancer Day was observed on 4th February 2026 with the theme "**United by Unique.**" The theme forms part of a three-year global campaign (2025–2027) led by the Union for International Cancer Control (UICC), emphasizing a people-centred approach to cancer care.
- **International Mother Language Day 2026:** International Mother Language Day 2026 was celebrated on 21st February 2026 with the theme "*Youth Voices on Multilingual Education.*" The day underscored the crucial role of young people in promoting linguistic diversity, preserving cultural heritage, and advocating for inclusive education systems that support and respect all languages.
- **7-Days Special Winter Camp:** The National Service Scheme (**NSS**) 7-Day Special Camp is an intensive, residential, and community-oriented programme, generally organized in adopted villages or urban slums with the objective of fostering social responsibility and community engagement among student volunteers. During the camp, volunteers from various colleges actively participated in activities such as cleanliness drives, health awareness programmes, literacy and education campaigns, and tree plantation initiatives. These engagements aim to cultivate leadership qualities, teamwork, and a spirit of selfless service among students, in line with the NSS motto, "*Not Me, But You.*"
- **Road Safety Week:** Road Safety Week was celebrated in all colleges during the m/o February to commemorate ‘Sadak Suraksha–Jeevan Raksha’. Road Safety Club in collaboration with NSS unit of the colleges organized various activities including awareness rallies and lectures in an effort to propagate the importance of safe roads among the general public.
- **Events highlighting ill effects of Drug Abuse:** Various activities were carried out under the aegis of the celebration of 5 years of Nasha Mukti Bharat Abhiyan (NMBA) such as Anti-Drug Rallies, Anti-smoking drive, Mental Health awareness programmes, seminars, Pledge ceremony, Painting / Quiz competitions, Intra College Sports Meet competitions and Nukkad Natak etc. in almost all the colleges of UT.

- **Plantation Drive & Cleanliness drive:** Cleanliness drive & Plantation drive was celebrated in almost all the colleges of J&K UT. NSS Unit of all the Colleges organized various activities viz., pledge taking ceremony, slogan writing, painting competitions, quiz competition, Rallies etc.

## 1. ECONOMIC SECTORS

### A. Agriculture:

- **Area coverage:** 50.00 thousand Ha area has been sown under different crops in Jammu and Kashmir during month of February, 2026 (Cumulative till date: 1317.312 thousand Ha).
- **Distribution of High Yielding Variety Seeds:** 21602.664 Qtls seed has been distributed among the farmers during the month (Cumulative till date: 127328.143 Qtls).
- **Distribution of Fertilizers:** 46607.93 MTs of major fertilizers (Urea-33734.52MT, DAP-3842.80 MT, MOP-5446.10MTs., And SSP- 2666.13 Others-918.38) have been made available to the farming community (Cumulative till date: 187683.27 MTs).
- **Testing of Fertilizers/Pesticide Samples:** 213samples of fertilizers, 444pesticides samples, 17 samples of Organic/Bio Fertilizers and 05 samples of Honey were tested in the quality control Labs during the month for ensuring supply of quality inputs (Fertilizer/PP Chemicals) to the farmers(Cumulative till date: Fertilizer: 1094,PP Chemicals:2145 Organic/Bio Fertilizers: 86 Honey:05).
- **Diagnosis of Insect Pest/Disease Samples:** 56 Samples/ Phytosanitary samples were tested and diagnosed in the Plant Health Clinics (PHCs)/Laboratories for various insect pest/diseases along with recommendations (Cumulative till date: 1002).

- **Testing of Seed Samples:** 73 Seed samples were tested for various parameters in the Seed Testing Laboratory during the month for ensuring distribution of quality seeds to the farmers (Cumulative till date: 2796).
- **Testing of Soil Samples:** 7981 Soil samples have been tested during the month (Cumulative till date: 109135) and 10225 Soil Health Cards (SHCs) were distributed during the month (Cumulative till date: 102474).
- **Production of Mushroom:** 5016.87 Qtls of mushroom has been produced and marketed during the reporting period (Cumulative till date: 31698 Qtls).
- **Production of Honey:** 4119.20 Qtls of Honey has been produced (Cumulative till date: 23179.84 Qtls).
- **Distribution of Vegetable Seedlings:-** 51.4 lakhs quality vegetable seedlings grown under protected conditions have been distributed among the farmers during the month (Cumulative till date:-427.28 lakhs)
- **Fabrication of Farm Machinery:** 887 assorted Tools & Implements and 07 Poly-green Houses have been fabricated in Government Workshop for supply to the farming community to ease human drudgeries(Cumulative till date:- Tools: 11602, Poly-green Houses: 206)
- **Command Area Development, Jammu/ Kashmir:** Covered 11228.96 hectares against the Physical Target of 16664.99 hectares under CAPEX Budget and 12202.20 hectares against the physical target of 11348.81 hectares under NABARD of OFD works by CAD ending February, 2026.

### SKUAST-Jammu/Kashmir:

- SKUAST-Jammu organised three days Agriculture Summit & Kisan Mela 2026 at its Chatha campus from February 11–13, 2026, which was inaugurated by Sh. Manoj Sinha, Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, J&K. The theme of this Summit was "AI-enabled Advanced Agriculture". This event showcased precision farming, modern machinery, and digital tools, featuring farmer-scientist interactions, workshops, and exhibitions to promote modern, sustainable farming.

- SKUAST-K in collaboration with 41-Battalion BSF launched two week Entrepreneurial Skill development certificate course on Hi-Tech mushroom farming at KVK Srinagar.
- SKUAST-K in collaboration with department of Agriculture conducted two day training program for Krishi Udyamis of KKG'S across the district Srinagar under the aegis of HADP 20.
- SKUAST-K took the possession of 500 kanals of land in district Anantnag for establishment of its South campus and completed the fencing of the site.
- SKUAST-K developed Chilli hybrid (CH-HPH-1) has been released at national level based on excellent performance across different testing centres during annual group meet of AICRP Vegetable crops.

### **Capacity Building**

- AICRP on Potential Crops at FoA Wadura SKUAST-K organized training cum input distribution programme at KVK Kupwara on 23rd October 2025.
- **Trainings:** 3 days Training programmes conducted one each in District Udhampur for 150 farmers, Samba for 15 farmers and Poonch for 24 farmers.
- **Demonstrations:** 03 No. of Demonstration camps held in District Udhampur at Ramkote, Ramnagar and Udhampur circle—J with participation of 150 farmers. One Demonstration camp held each in District Jammu for 50 farmers and in District Samba for 15 farmers.
- **Exposure visits:** 23 Rearers from different districts of Kashmir taken to Himachal Pradesh on an Exposure visit. In addition Exposure visit within the Jammu Division conducted with participation of 100 rearers from Udhampur and 15 from Samba.

### **Sericulture Sector:**

- **Mulberry Plantation:** During the current month Mulberry plantation to the tune of 101810 conducted with 59810 No. in District Reasi, 30,000 No. in District Ramban and 6000 No. each in District Doda and Kishtwar.
- **Silkworm rearing:** Necessary arrangements have been made at field level for conducting spring rearing in Jammu Division. A total of 5452 Oz of commercial silkworm seed has been put for incubation in District Jammu, Samba Kathua Udhampur and Reasi during the current month.
- **Silkworm Seed Production:** The production of Silkworm Seed in Departmental Basic Seed Stations has been started. During the current month 900 Dfls of Seed has been put for P2 level rearing in different Seed Stations of Jammu Division.

### **B. Horticulture:**

- **Export and Dispatch of Fruit:** 45563.00 MT Fresh fruit of fruit have been dispatched outside the UT of Jammu and Kashmir to other markets of country during February, 2026.
- **e-NAM Platform:** 395 farmers, 05 traders, 03 Commission Agent and 06 FPOs/Cooperative Societies have been registered on e-NAM portal for performing online business upto February, 2026. Business worth ₹ 69001.46 lakhs for 1229952.70 quintals of Agri/Horti produce has been made on the e-NAM portal upto February, 2026.
- **PM-FME Scheme:** Under the scheme, educated youths are being sensitized to establish micro processing units and upgrade existing units. Against 4190 applications submitted, loan has been sanctioned in favor of 2354 applicants and disbursed to 1791 beneficiaries ending February, 2026.
- **Buyer Seller meet:** The Department organized a Buyer–Seller Meet at Salt Lake, Kolkata from 20.09.2025 to 21.09.2025, with participation of around 300 buyers and sellers. The First Multi-Stakeholder Platform (MSP) Meet of 2025 under JKCIP was held on 08.10.2025 at DIPR, Polo Ground Srinagar, with participation of Director Horticulture (P&M), heads of departments, SKUAST-K, and an IFAD delegation, who interacted with various FPOs and sellers.
- Subsequently, the Second MSP Meet was conducted on 18.12.2025 at Kissan Kendra, Talab Tillo, Jammu. Further, two meetings were held in February 2026, at New Delhi (12.02.2026) and KissanGhar, Narwal Jammu (25.02.2026), focusing on collaboration, market linkages, and strategic planning for strengthening the horticulture sector.
- **Unified Licenses:** During the year 2025-26, 230 unified licenses have been issued during the month of February, 2026 aggregating the total license to the extent of 1982.
- **Export of cherry:** 1869 MT of cherry has been dispatched from various F&V markets to other parts of country like Delhi, Mumbai, Banglore, Kolkata etc comprising of 18,69,000 boxes thereby carrying a business of Rs 21.96 crore during the year 2025-26 upto ending February, 2026.
- **Awareness Camps:** A total of 1,795 Mobile Demonstrations and 210 Training/Awareness Camps have been conducted. **C. Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation & Reconstruction Department:**

- Under PMRP-2008, 3000 posts were announced for the unemployed Kashmiri Migrants Youths. Also, under PMDP-2015, another 3000 posts were announced, thus totalling 6000 posts.
