Project Monitoring Group (PMG)

Project Monitoring Group (PMG) is an institutional mechanism for expeditious resolution of issues and regulatory bottlenecks in projects with an investment of INR 500 crores and above in India. It was set up as a special cell in the Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India in 2013 and was subsequently brought under the Administrative control of the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) in 2015. In February 2019, PMG was merged with Invest India, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce.

PMG seeks to enlist unresolved project issues of all Public, Private and 'Public–Private Partnership' (PPP) Projects and undertakes fast-tracking of approvals, sectoral policy issues and removal of bottlenecks in their expeditious commissioning. DPIIT is mandated as the nodal body for the review of Public and Private Projects facing challenges and facilitates their resolution through PMG.

In short, issues pertaining to PRAGATI reviewed projects as well as other projects enlisted on PMG portal are reviewed from time to time.

Presently, 05 No of pending issues have been received from Project Monitoring Group, and forwarded to the concerned Administrative Departments for resolving these issues pertaining to them
