

## **Training Workshop Output Outcome Monitoring Framework (OOMF)**

- A Two-day workshop on Output-Outcome Monitoring Framework (OOMF) was organized by Planning Development and Monitoring Department, Jammu & Kashmir, in collaboration with Development Monitoring & Evaluation Office (DMEO), NITI Aayog, GoI, on 22<sup>nd</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2021, at, Convention Centre, Jammu.
- The workshop was chaired by Mr. Sekhar Bonu, Director General, DMEO, NITI Aayog, GoI. The resource persons were from NITI Aayog, GoI. The workshop aimed at sensitizing and building greater understanding of officers of Economics and Statistics Cadre of Jammu & Kashmir on Output-Outcome Monitoring Framework. The Framework endeavours to provide measurable indicators for achievement of scheme objectives, or the 'Outcomes'. Actively tracking progress against defined targets provides two key benefits for governance: improving (i) the development impact and (ii) the public accountability of every rupee spent by the Government.
- OOMF was framed for schemes of 9 sectors/ departments (Health & Medical Education, Higher Education, Power Development, Public Works, Jal Shakti, Social Welfare, Rural Development, Housing & Urban Development & Agriculture Production) in consultation with Department Monitoring & Evaluation Office (DMEO), GOI, during financial Year 2022-23.
- Secretary PD&MD and Officers of E&S Cadre from PD&MD, Directorate of Economics & Statistics and concerned Administrative Departments attended the workshop in which broader contours of OOMF Framework were finalized with NITI Aayog Team headed by Dr. Shekhar Bonu.
- OOMF framed exercise shall be carried on further in financial year 2023-24 for schemes of Other Departments as well.
